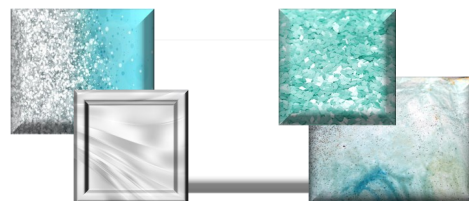

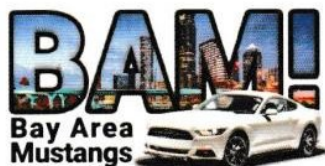

Two years later, Harry parked a beautiful 1966 Mustang convertible out on his front lot just before closing on a Saturday night. He knew putting the car out there all weekend would get a lot of interest.

The next afternoon, my friend picked me up and said, "let's go for a ride!" She drove me past Harry's used car lot, where I saw the Mustang parked out front.

My friend knew how much I wanted to find a convertible Mustang, and when I got out of her car -- it was love at first sight!

When I got home, I ran up the stairs, interrupting my parents talking at the kitchen table. I had to tell them I found MY car. My mom laughed because my parents just happened to be discussing the same car! My mom saw the Mustang on her way home from Bingo, when there were a lot of people standing around looking at the car.

Mom told me she was a little mad since Harry promised her two years earlier he'd look for a Mustang for me, but never called them about the car. Luckily, she had his home number and called him that

Sunday night. Harry Dunn remembered my parents request and promised my mom he would open early on Monday for her to look at the car.

So, on September 26, 1983, my mom went early and took a test drive. She put down a ten dollar deposit until she could get to the bank later in the day. As mom signed the papers, my father's boss walked into the office with cash to buy the Mustang -- only to find that the car was sold! OOPS!

Later that week "My Little Girl" came home and I have had her ever since. My car, just like me, was born in 1966. She was in her original condition with only 29,000 miles. That year, it snowed just about every other day and my parents made me wait until spring when the weather improved.

This meant I only got to drive my car to high school for 7 weeks. The only work I ever needed on her back then was four new tires and a radiator, along with that the usual oil change and routine maintenance. She was my daily driver from 1984 to 1990 and while in NJ, I made several trips with her driving down to the Jersey shore.

"My Little Girl" was built in Metuchen, NJ, only 10 miles from where I grew up. She has a 200ci straight 6 automatic transmission, Ivy Green Metallic with Parchment interior and came standard with bench seats - only 3,190 convertibles manufactured with bench seats in 1966.

I love my car because its different and unique from everyone else's. The previous owner had the rear springs altered, adding another leaf so the car sits level ... many people notice that right away.

I joined the North Jersey Mustang Club (NJMC) and met many more enthusiasts like me! My car was featured in several parades and car shows while in NJ. In 1989, I was able to attend the 25th Mustang Anniversary Celebration in Flushing Meadows, NY and got to meet Lee Iacocca.

The party was only for people who arrived in their Mustang's and I attended with other members of NJMC.

By 1993, my husband and I moved to Florida and our new home construction was completed in 1994. The following year, my parents hauled my Mustang the 1,100 miles from NJ to welcome her to her new home.

By 1996, I had my Mustang completely restored by Stu Rogers at Cal Roberts Auto Body in Seminole, FL. He worked on the car for over a year and completed an entire frame up restoration. I wanted to keep her as original as possible.

I enjoyed my car up until my daughter came along in 2000. By then, I pretty much stopped taking the car out because it had no seat belts. So "My Little Girl" sat for seventeen years, covered and kept in the garage.

XSteeda Q850 Streetfighter Debuts as Beefed Up Mustang GT



In recent months, long-time tuner Steeda has launched a number of new products for the Ford Mustang, including a catback exhaust system and MagneRide controller, as well as the SSV police pursuit model. Now, it has something even bigger up its proverbial sleeve – the brand new Steeda Q850 StreetFighter, which is a supremely powerful and appropriate send-off for the S550-generation Mustang GT that offers up stellar performance, to boot.

The Steeda Q850 StreetFighter is actually the most capable road-going car that particular company has ever built and sold to the public, with the bulk of that coming from a Steeda/Whipple 3.0L Stage 2 supercharger system, along with a high-flow cold-air intake and a unique PCM calibration, which helps the pony car's Ford 5.0L V8 Coyote engine crank out an impressive 825 horsepower and 640 pound-feet of torque, which will reportedly propel it from 0-60 miles-per-hour in 3.1 seconds, to 100 mph in 10 seconds, and down the quarter-mile in 10.23 seconds at 146 mph.

Customers can opt for either a six-speed manual transmission – which is treated to a Steeda Tri-Ax shifter and clutch spring assist and spring perch kit upgrade – or 10-speed automatic. Steeda didn't leave the Mustang GT's suspension alone either, instead treating it to a laundry list of upgrades including its own dual-rate springs, sway bars, sway bar mounts, IRS bushings, adjustable rear toe links, aluminum vertical links, bump steer kit, G-Trac K-member and IRS support braces, camber plates, subframe alignment, and performance wheel alignment.

The Steeda Q850 StreetFighter is pretty easy to distinguish from regular Mustang GT models thanks to Steeda graphics and badging, an aerodynamic front fascia enhancement package, rear spoiler, Q-Series hood blackout treatment, and 20-inch McQueen Racing Wheels by Steeda wrapped with Nitto NT555 G2 tires. Inside the cabin, the special pony car has been treated to StreetFighter door sill plates and dashboard emblem.

Pricing for the Steeda Q850 StreetFighter starts out at \$34,995 – minus the donor vehicle – though a host of additional, optional upgrades are also available, such as an upgraded cooling package, slotted two-piece brake rotors, a roll cage, rear seat delete, and different wheels. For those looking for the ultimate version of the current-gen pony car, well, it's certainly a compelling option, if nothing else, and those interested in reserving one can do so by heading over here.
